

Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA)
Initial Request

Government Fee: \$495 check/money order payable to the Department of Homeland Security

NCICC Fee: \$160 (Pro bono services are available to those who qualify)

Required Documents: (Please bring to your first appointment)

- **Evidence of Identity and age**
 - Passport; or
 - Birth certificate (with other photo ID)
 - Consular photo ID
 - Other U.S. government ID or school ID bearing your name and photo

- **Evidence of Education**
 - High School Diploma, GED, HiSet or TASC Certificate; or
 - High School Transcript;
 - Evidence that you are currently enrolled in an educational, literacy or career training program.

- **Evidence of ANY Criminal Charges**

- **Evidence of Physical Presence in the U.S.**
 - Documents should prove presence for every quarter of every year starting on June 15, 2007 until present
 - A few documents may cover almost all periods: example, a 17 year old still attending school could provide transcripts of school since 2007.
 - If you were older than 16 on June 15, 2007, you must provide evidence that you entered the country before your 16th birthday
 - Suggested documents include school records, medical records, employment records, rent receipts, utility bills, mortgages, bank transactions, immigration records

Application Information:

- List of ALL addresses where you have resided in the U.S. with dates (*dd/mm/yy to dd/mm/yy*)
- Place and date of your initial entry into the U.S.
- Passport number and expiration date of your most recent passport
- Your current annual income and expenses
